Decision

The appeal is allowed. The matter will go back to the General Division for reconsideration by a different member.

Background

The Canada Employment Insurance Commission decided not to pay

S. M. (Claimant) employment insurance benefits because she lost her employment as a result of misconduct. The Claimant appealed to the General Division. The General Division summarily dismissed the appeal.

The Claimant now appeals to the Appeal Division.

The parties agree on the outcome of the appeal

The parties agree that the General Division made a legal error by summarily dismissing the Claimant's appeal. They agree that the matter should return to the General Division for a hearing on the merits.

I accept the proposed outcome. The General Division stated but did not apply the proper test for summary dismissal.

For the Claimant's information, the General Division will open a new file. It will include the documents already submitted by the parties. If they want to, the parties can file additional documents prior to the hearing.
